
# Organizer

# Developing and implementing a molecular tumor board

The cancer center of SLK Kliniken Heilbronn is showing the structure and regular implementation of their molecular tumor board as an example. Focusing on organizational and technical optimization, the participants actively discuss and introduce their personal experiences.

# Interoperability of knowledge databases

There is a great diversity of data sources worldwide which e.g. provide information on genetic alterations of cancer diseases. However, linking and evaluating the data can be quite difficult. On one side there is semantic interoperability, which means joining data of the same type from different databases. On the other side we have to consider technical interoperability, which focuses on standardized interfaces. Achieving interoperable databases allows us to use knowledge worldwide for decision support in everyday clinical practice.

# Study designs for personalized medicine

Present study designs are based on large groups of patients e.g. for testing the efficacy of medication. However, personalized medicine focuses on customized therapies for one single patient. Participants discuss possible solution approaches for selected topics (immuno-oncology, DNA repair, cell cycle).



# **Approach**

#### Directions by car

The closest parking garage can be found at "Parkplatz Rollschuhhalle" at Mannheimer Str. 39, 74076 Heilbronn. Walking distance to the venue: 5 min

Nearby the venue you can find a parking garage with over 500 parking places. The address of the parking garage is Weipertstraße 51, 74076 Heilbronn. Walking distance to the venue: 8 min.

Please note that the parking garages demand parking fees.

#### Directions by bus

Several inner-city and regional bus lines go to the education campus (venue). Possible stops are "Am Europaplatz" and "Hallenbad Soleo".

#### Directions by train

#### With the S42 from Neckarsulm

Heading to Heilbronn, please stop at "Theater" station. From here, walk on Mannheimer Straße towards Europaplatz. Walking distance: 5 min

#### With the S4 from Baden-Baden, Karlsruhe, Eppingen, Heilbronn or Östringen

With the light rail S4 between Baden-Baden / Karlsruhe / Östringen you reach the city of Heilbronn easily. At the Harmonie stop, change to the S42 in the direction of Neckarsulm. The Theater stop is just a 5-minute walk from the Bildungscampus.

#### By train from Würzburg, Stuttgart, Mannheim or Heidelberg

Heilbronn is connected to the ICE stops in Würzburg, Stuttgart and Mannheim. From Heilbronn main station or the Willy-Brandt-Platz station (station forecourt), take the S42 tram to the Theater stop. From here, walk on Mannheimer

Straße towards Europaplatz. Walking distance: 5 min

#### Directions from airport

Landing in Stuttgart or Frankfurt airport.

Both airports are connected to the Deutsche Bahn (German railway) network.

The S-Bahn lines S2 and S3 run on weekdays every 10 minutes and on weekends every 30 minutes between Stuttgart Airport and Stuttgart Main Station. From Stuttgart Central Station there are connecting trains to Heilbronn available. Arriving at Heilbronn main station, continue from Willy-Brandt-Platz (station forecourt) as described above with tram S42.

Frankfurt Airport has its own ICE train station. From Mannheim / Heidelberg take regional trains to Heilbronn main station - from there continue on the S42 urban railway as described above.
